Dr. Dick Bransford – US Missionary to Africa

Dr. Bransford, a trained general surgeon having specialized in tropical diseases, has worked throughout eastern and central Africa as a general surgeon but is also involved in plastics and orthopedics, and ultimately “rehab surgery”. He works with disabled children afflicted with polio, club feet, cleft lips, burn contractures, hydrocephalus, spina bifida, and other congenital and acquired abnormalities. Disasters have also taken Dr. Bransford to Somalia in 1993, Rwanda during the genocide in 1994, Zaire to work with refugees in 1995, and South Sudan among many other countries.

Tony has served in churches and ministries in several African countries and taught in the Philosophy Department at Denver Seminar.
