# God's amazing Sovereignty

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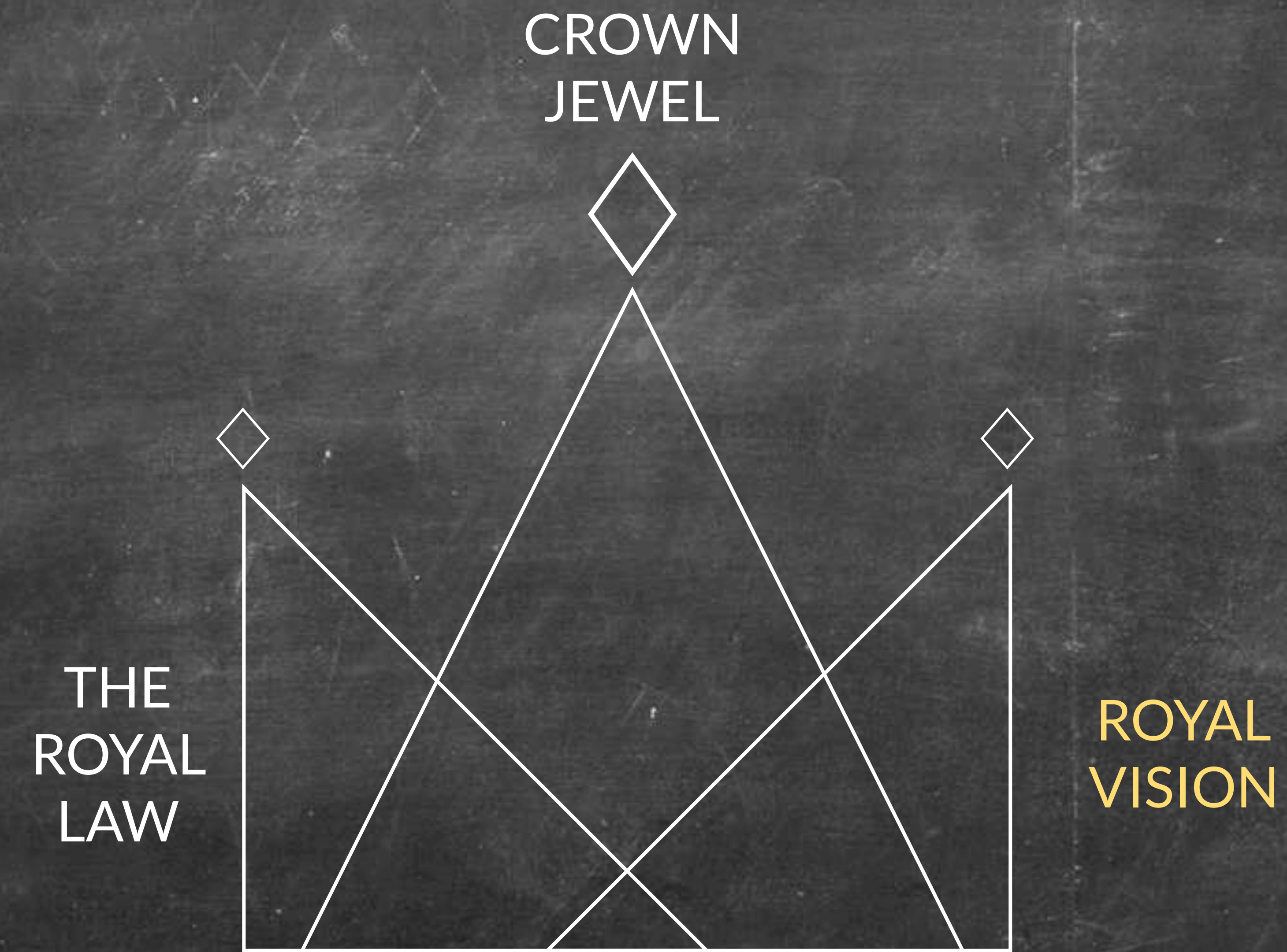
The Royal Law: Love your **neighbor**

gentleness

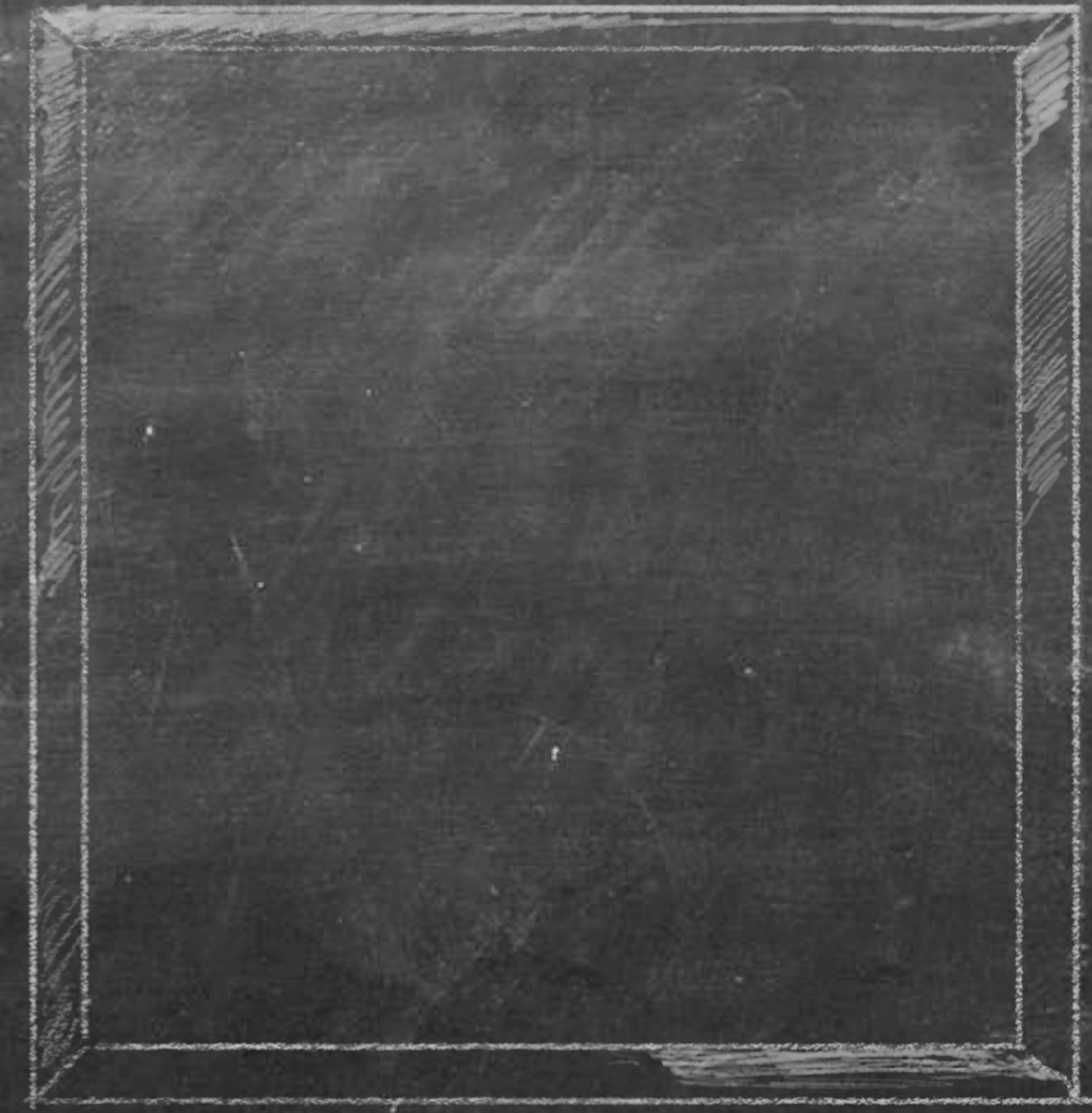
