Families in Michigan need a strong unified voice for their homeschool freedom and a community of support in their calling. We empower, encourage, and defend Christian homeschoolers.

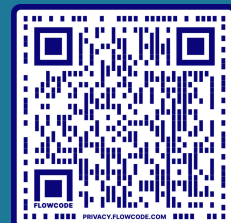
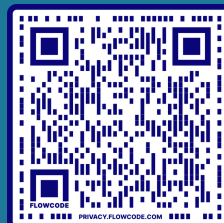
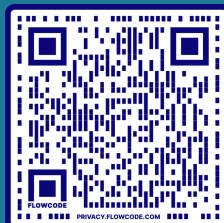
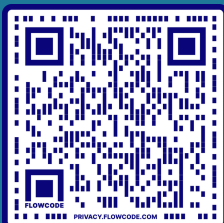

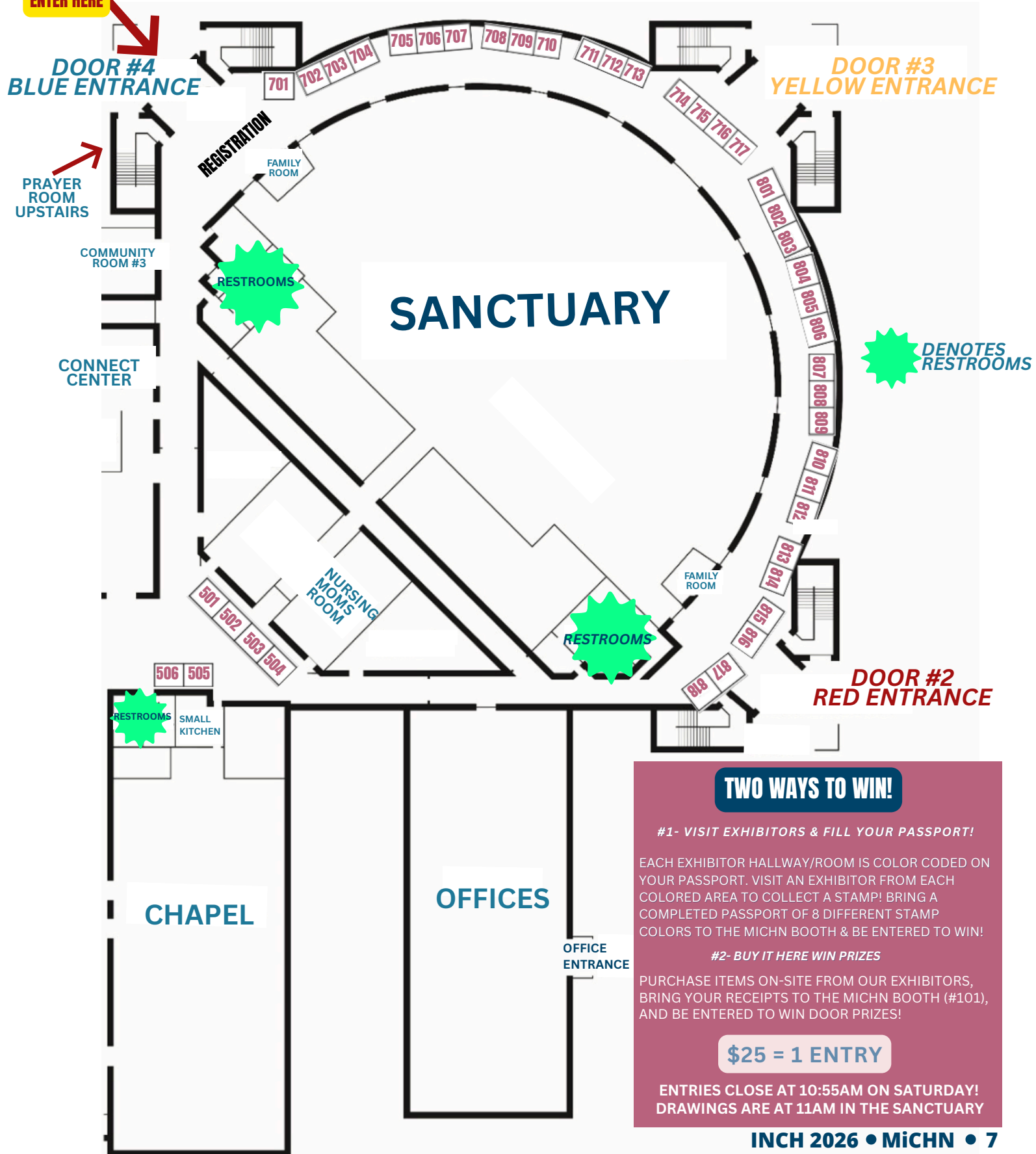
