What are you a disciple of?
Discipled by **Christ** or Discipled by **Culture**?

If you want to be discipled by Christ... need to know Jesus, become like Him and thus do what He does

Be with Jesus (solitude)

Henri Nouwen: "without solitude it is virtually impossible to live a spiritual life" Be like Jesus (transformation)

Do what Jesus Did (service)

Go in the right order!

Living in Community:

Solitude vs. Alone

Spiritual life must start with solitude but our **life of service cannot be done alone.** Community is crucial for **sustainability** and **strength**.

Community- intentionally finding a community that sharpens each other to become like Christ *talk **house church** model- rubbing shoulders with humans is beauty and challenging all at the same time T18 and Cancer

Compassion vs Conflict

Community brings an opportunity for compassion- baring each others burdens **AND conflicts**

Conflict can lead to deeper relationships, reconciliation and restoration are all part of kingdom building

Conflict is not fighting, in fact fighting is the *avoidance* of conflict (fight, flight or freeze). The avoidance of conflict is *not* a sign of a healthy relationship, in fact healthy conflict draws relationships closer, vulnerability is necessary, a skill we can learn, the more conflict we have in a healthy manner- strong trust is built. Conflict leads to intimacy, unity, communication and connectivity

Perspective

Living among my patient population changed my perspective. The problems of the community became my problem.
