Prayer Call for Reversal of FDA Abortion Drug Approval

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RESULTS SAME BY SURGERY OR BY PILLS



Most babies aborted in the United States are now murdered using abortion drugs. The divisions in America over abortion (and other life, identity, moral, family issues) are growing deeper, and the battles over righteousness and justice more intense. One of the most intense is over the availability of Mifepristone (RU-486, Mifeprex), the abortion drug. Some are calling the Federal Drug Administration (FDA) to restore restrictions and consider reversing its original approval, and others are

calling for removal of all restrictions. Appeals are currently before the FDA and Trump Administration. It's time to pray! Here's a few facts to guide you:

- 1873: The Comstock Act prohibited mailing substances, drugs, medicines or anything that could cause an abortion (see, "[Mifepristone and the Comstock Act](#)," Mary Szoch, FRC).
- 2000: FDA approved Mifepristone as a drug to induce an abortion; and developed Risk Evaluation and Mitigation Strategies (REMS) to minimize threats to the life of the mother.
- 2017-2020: Trump Administration supported the REMS.
- 2020: the ACLU won a court decision to suspend the REMS during the Covid pandemic.
- 2021: the U.S. Supreme Court restored the REMS.
- 2021: the Biden Administration removed the REMS, so that a physician no longer had to examine and care for the pregnant woman; the abortion pills no longer required a physician's approval or prescription; and abortion pills could be sent by mail.
- 2023: the American Medical Association (AMA) issued a statement opposing restrictions on Mifepristone ("[Restored restrictions on mifepristone is a step backwards](#)").
- 2025-01: The second Trump Administration supports the REMS.
- 2025-01-31: The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) appealed to the FDA to remove the REMS and any other "burdens associated with prescribing or dispensing mifepristone" (quoted in July 29, 2025, FRC letter to FDA; see below).
- 2025-06-05: The Attorney General of Massachusetts, joined by California, New Jersey, and New York, appealed to the FDA to "remove Mifepristone REMS ... including but not limited to the Prescriber Certification, Pharmacy Certification, and Patient Agreement form" – so

that anyone can sell and dispense the drug, and no physician need be involved, and no patient consent form (quoted in August 5, 2025, FRC letter to FDA).

- 2025-07-02: GenBioPro, markets and sells Mifepristone in the USA, appealed to the FDA to not enforce, or add to, any restrictions to “prescribing or dispensing mifepristone” (quoted in August 4, 2025, FRC letter to FDA).
- 2025-07-29: The Family Research Council (FRC) submitted a letter to the FDA opposing ACOG’s request, citing many documented dangers of Mifepristone, and requested the FDA “reconsider its approval altogether” (“[Public comment in response to \[ACOG\]](#)”).
- 2025-08-04: FRC submitted a similar letter to the FDA opposing GenBioPro’s requests, citing the Ethics and Public Policy Center extensive study that documented “10.93 percent of women experienced sepsis, infection, hemorrhaging, a trip to the emergency room, a follow-up surgical abortion, or another serious event within 45 days of a prescribed mifepristone abortion” (“[Public comment in response to ... GenBioPro, Inc.](#)”).
- 2025-08-05: FRC submitted a similar letter to the FDA opposing the Massachusetts, et. al., requests (“[Public comment in response to ... Massachusetts, et. al.](#)”).

PRAY that the Trump Administration and FDA will reverse the evil policy authorizing Mifepristone and restore enforcement of the Comstock Act. Also, that the Trump Administration and Congress would enact a new law prohibiting the sale, disbursement, and mailing of any substances, drugs, medicines or anything else designed and intended to be used to abort a baby, both nationwide and across state lines, based on the 5th and 14th Amendments to the United States Constitution.
