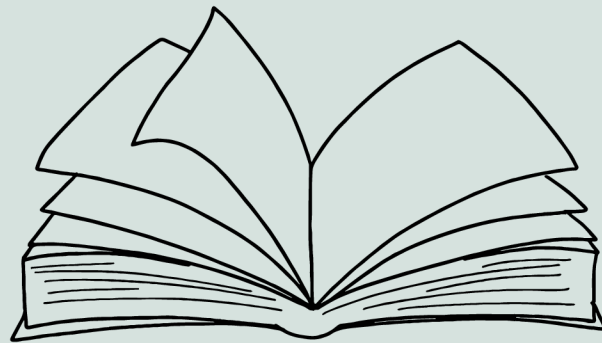

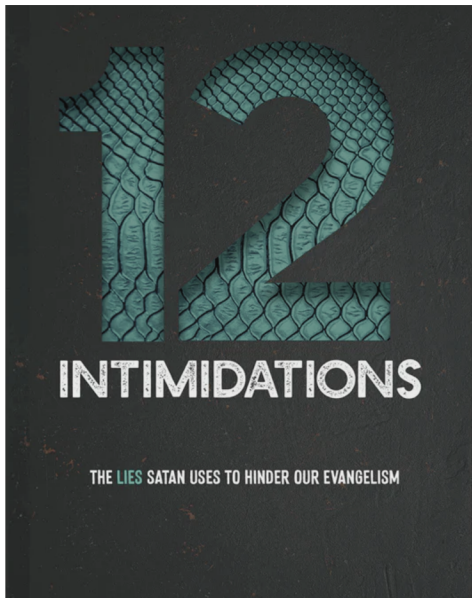

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Week 1

Intimidation 1

- 1 When have you put too much pressure upon yourself to know more of the Bible before you shared your faith? Can you think of a specific time?
- 2 Why and how should the realization that if you know the 10 words that constitute the gospel provide both relief and boldness in evangelism

Intimidation 2

- 1 When have you been in a situation where upon being asked a question you could not answer, saying “I don’t know’ is all you would have needed to say?
- 2 How many times have you actually been asked a question you could not answer?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Week 2

Intimidation 3

- 1 How does admitting your faults but not being held back by them, help you overcome this intimidation Satan uses?
- 2 How ought the realization that you are presenting a perfect Christ (not a perfect Christian) increase your boldness in evangelism?

Intimidation 4

- 1 How and where have you concentrated too much on their relationship with you instead of their relationship with Christ?
- 2 How should the difference between thinking, “I might lose a friend” and “I will lose a friend” impact your evangelism?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Week 3

Intimidation 5

- 1 How might the idea of “tomorrow” instead of “today” cause you to neglect opportunities to evangelize this week?
- 2 Can you think of anyone you have met that when they were a non-Christian wanted to discuss spiritual things but did not know how to bring up the subject?

Intimidation 6

- 1 How and where can you grasp training opportunities this month that will help you to better communicate your faith to others?
- 2 How has the fear of making a mistake been prevalent in your mind when faced with witnessing opportunities?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Week 4

Intimidation 7

- 1 Why should the matter of an unbeliever's salvation and yours be two separate issues?
- 2 How might you have allowed Satan to argue with you about your salvation instead of directing him to God?

Intimidation 8

- 1 You and the person you are talking to are not promised tomorrow. How should this impact every witnessing opportunity you have?
- 2 How should the idea that you can always back off, when necessary, encourage your boldness to go forward in evangelism?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Week 5

Intimidation 9

- 1 Have you looked at yourself each day as someone who is in full-time ministry
- 2 Why as a disciple of Christ do you have a responsibility in evangelism even though you may not have the gift of evangelism?

Intimidation 10

- 1 As you reflect on the past, how has God taught you through your mistakes in evangelism?
- 2 Why is it wrong to call yourself a failure because of mistakes you made when sharing your faith?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Week 6

Intimidation 11

- 1 What might consistency in evangelism prove to you and how will it help you?
- 2 Why is it never a waste of your time to evangelize?

Intimidation 12

- 1 How does living the life around non-Christians give you even more credibility and opportunity in evangelism?
- 2 How would you respond to a Christian who believes their moral lifestyle is enough to bring Christ to the lost?

SUGGESTED GROUP ACTIVITIES

Want to add interactive activities to your meetings? Check out some of the activities we've come up with below. Feel free to use as few or many as you want to better suit the needs of your group.

Scripture Memory Challenge

How it works: Challenge participants to memorize verses that combat fear and lies. Some suggested verses include:

- 2 Timothy 1:7
- Romans 1:16
- Matthew 28:19-20
- Acts 1:8
- 1 Peter 3:15
- John 14:26
- Ephesians 6:19-20
- Colossians 4:5-6
- Isaiah 41:10
- Philippians 1:6

Challenge members to memorize one verse per week.

Prayer & Accountability Pairs

Pair up members to:

- Pray for boldness and open opportunities
- Share one person to whom they want to witness.
- Give time each week to check in on progress and pray together

Encouragement Postcards

- Have each person write an anonymous encouraging postcard as if they're talking to someone who is afraid to share their faith.
- Decorate the cards with fun stickers, doodles, etc.
- Shuffle and hand them out randomly at the end.

SUGGESTED GROUP ACTIVITIES

“Truth Bites” Snack Night

- Each person brings a snack inspired by a truth that counters one of the 12 lies.
- They label it with the lie + the truth that counters it.

Examples

- “Fear Not Fruit Salad” for the lie, “You should be afraid of rejection.”
- “Bold Believer Pretzel Bites” for the lie, “You’re not bold enough to share your faith.”
- “Clarity Cheeseboard” for the lie, “People won’t understand the gospel.”
- “Little is Much Munch Mix” for the lie, “You don’t know enough to share.”
- “Grace-covered Cupcakes” for the lie, “You’ll mess it up.”
- “Now or Never Nachos” for the lie, “It’s not the right time.”
- “Open Ears Popcorn” for the lie, “People don’t want to listen.”
- “Love Over Logic Lemon Bars” for the lie, “You need to win the argument.”
- “Imperfect Pizza Bites” for the lie, “You need to be perfect.”

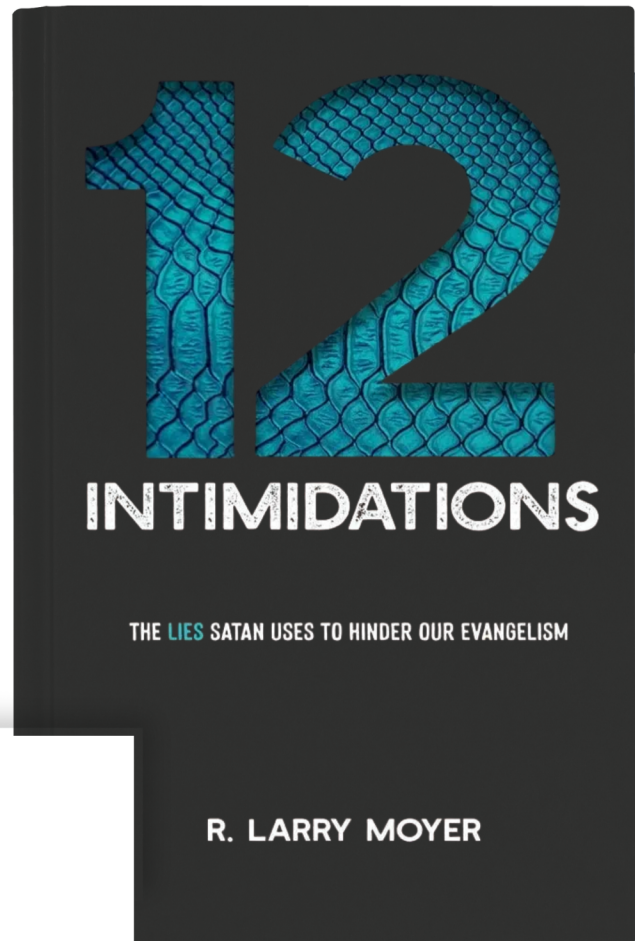

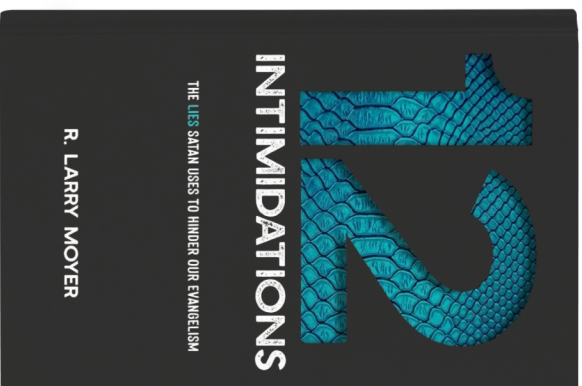

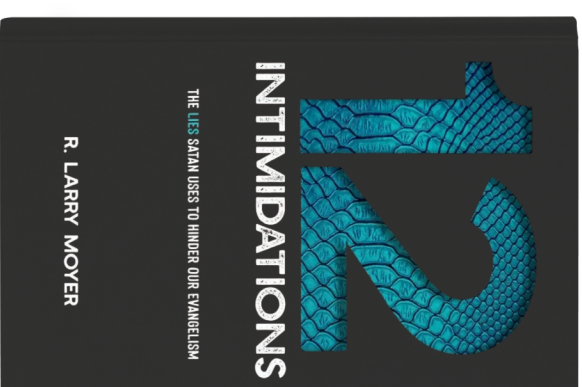
