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Rededicate America Report

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On July 3 and 4, Intercessors for America (IFA) hosted the Rededicate America conference at the Museum of the Bible in Washington, DC (www.IFAPray.org). The focus themes were:

1. Recount: remember what GOD has done in our history with gratitude;
2. Reclaim: remember and reclaim the covenants prior generations made with GOD; and
3. Rededicate: together we rededicated our nation to GOD.

1. **RECOUNT:** Dr. Jim Garlow was the first main speaker and gave us an amazing overview, recounting GOD's hand in American history from the early 1600s. Here are a few of his profound statements:

"Had there been no Great Awakening there would not have been an American Revolution. . . . The Founding Fathers structured the government on the Torah structure of government. . . . The most notable characteristic of the Founding Fathers was their knowledge and deep understanding of the Bible. The most quoted book by the Founding Fathers was the Bible."

Dr. Garlow led us in prayer for the restoration of the Biblical foundations of this nation.

David Kubal, CEO of IFA, spoke: "Ronald Reagan declared: 'Freedom is never more than one generation away from extinction.' . . . Recount #1: Those before us established generational covenants. . . . God reminded Isaac He would bless him because of the obedience of his father Abraham. Covenants by God remain intact, and He remains committed to uphold them. . . . Recount #2: We take possession because we are blessed. But expect opposition; it will come. . . . Recount #3: Re-digging the wells IS re-digging the blessings of generational covenant, of generational covenants of blessing."

2. **RECLAIM:** David Kubal also spoke on this topic, challenging us to: "Reclaim God's promise to our nation. Reclaim the covenants that God has made with us. The Pilgrims saw themselves as modern day Israelites taking the land for His glory. The founding generations made covenants with God dedicating this land to Him. . . . RECLAIM: We can establish generational covenants with God. We are reclaiming the covenants made by those who went before us. The covenants with GOD started in 1579:

- June 1579: The priest with Sir Frances Drake in San Francisco prayed for the first time with the indigenous people, that the Lord would open their blind eyes.
- June 21, 1607: Robert Hunt, on Virginia Beach, prayed: 'We hereby dedicate this land ourselves to reach these people on these shores for the Lord Jesus Christ, and may this covenant endure to all generations . . .'

- November 11, 1620: The Pilgrims wrote and signed the Mayflower Compact.
- July 4, 1776: The American Colonists signed the Declaration of Independence.
- June 28, 1787: Benjamin Franklin's speech to the Continental Congress, calling the representatives of the nation to pray and ask for GOD's help.
- April 30, 1799: George Washington in his Farewell Address called the nation to remember and rely on GOD.
- 1954: The United States Pledge of Allegiance (the current version was authorized when President Dwight D. Eisenhower added 'under GOD').
- July 30, 1956: 'In God we trust' became our national motto, and was put on the one dollar bill."

3. **REDEDICATE:** Dutch Sheets spoke on the topic of rededication. He reviewed four Hebrew and Greek words meaning "dedicate," which mean:

- Train, school, instruct, "train up a child in the way he should go";
- Dedicated to one exclusively;
- Holy, separated to, dedicated to solely and completely.

"If we are rededicating our nation to God, we are rededicating to His purpose. God needs a willing people who will dedicate themselves to Him and pray. On May 17, 2026 (Rededicate America 250 event on the National Mall), we saw a Biblical pattern unfolding that was the Lord's doing. Now God can pour out His Spirit, which will be the greatest outpouring of His Spirit in history. We are moving into an unprecedented time of history because of what God is doing, and is because of all the prayer and intercession for a long time."

All 400 of us at the Rededicate America conference, with David Kubal leading us, rededicated America to GOD. Praise The LORD!
