IPC Reveals Strategic Changes from Contraception to Abortion, and Surgical to Chemical Abortion

This week (13-18 July 2025), the **30th** International Population Conference (IPC 2025) is being held in Brisbane, Australia. More accurate names would be International De-Population Conference; or Strategic Conference to Create a Global Shift from Contraception to Abortion, or Global Shift from Surgical Abortion to Chemical Abortion; or Global Strategy to Make Abortion Pills

Available Through Every Pharmacy and Drug Store Without Accountability; or International Conference to Remove All Barriers to Sexual Activity and Abortion; or How to Encourage Young Unmarried People to Have Sex and Avoid "Undesired Births"; or Making Abortion a National and International "Human Right."

Here is a sample of the IPC 2025 session topics [my comments in brackets]:

- Session 2: Sexual and Reproductive Health, Abortion, Adolescent Pregnancies Plenary: Global Threats [any substantial opposition] to Sexual and Reproductive Health;
- Session 63: Sexual and Reproductive Health During Crisis: Social Norms and Premarital Use of Family Planning Among Adolescents and Young People in Uganda;
- Session 72: Moving Family Planning Measurement Forward with a Rights and Justice Lens;
- Session 73: Sexuality, Health and Rights: LGBTQ Populations: Barriers to the Enjoyment of Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights for Lesbian and Bisexual Adolescent Girls and Young Women in Mozambique;
- Session 105: Progress and Barriers in Accessing Legal Abortion Services in Argentina;
- Disparities in Access to Abortion Care [universal access is their goal];
- Abortion, Contraception, and LGBTQI Rights: Examining the anti-SRHR agenda in Sub-Saharan Africa;
- Session 116: Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights [means full access to contraception, abortion, after-abortion care for children, teens, and adults without reference to morality, marriage, spouse, parents, etc.];

- Session 138: Medical Abortion: Safety and Methods: Medication Abortion Stock and Willingness to See in Pharmacies and Drug Stores in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia;
- Spotlight Session: Progress Through Partnerships for Safe Abortion Access in Africa;
- Session 189: Contraceptive Use and Discontinuation: Abortion Rather than Contraception: The Pathway to Fertility Transition in Pakistan.
