Watch Charlie Kirk Memorial Service & what Erika shared

The Memorial Service for Charlie Kirk was like no other in United States history. It was a blend of worship, honoring Jesus Christ as the central focus of Charlie's life, an evangelistic crusade, patriotism, and some politics. When challenged, many stood up and gave their lives to Jesus Christ. Praise the LORD!

On Sunday, 21 September 2025, the gates of State Farm Stadium in Glendale, Arizona, were opened at 8:00 a.m., with the formal service scheduled to begin at 11:00 a.m. Worship to The LORD began immediately and continued for 3 hours and 21 minutes before the first speaker, Pastor Rob McCoy (Charlie & Erika's pastor). Then for 5 hours, one speaker after another, with intermittent periods of worship, spoke from their hearts about Charlie. They shared about his strong faith in Jesus Christ, Godly character, extraordinary mind and debate capacities, kindness, and love for his wife, children, youth, and our nation. The speakers were leaders of Turning Point USA, close friends, members of Congress, members of the Trump Administration cabinet, and Mrs. Erika Kirk. See entire event at: <https://tpusa.com>

Senator Marco Rubio gave a bold and clear Biblical and gospel message, and spoke about Charlie's profound impact upon young men, challenged them to "get married, start a family and love your country" (start at 5:53 minutes).

Then Pete Hegseth, Secretary of War (start 6:00), spoke and said at the end of his remarks: "Charlie Kirk, a warrior for country, a warrior for Christ. He ran the race, he finished the fight. Now it's our turn. My charge to all of you is to live worthy of Charlie Kirk's sacrifice, and put Christ at the center of your life, as he advocated for, giving his."

Then Robert F. Kennedy, Jr., Secretary of Health & Human Services (start 6:07), began by saying: "Charlie's overarching passion was his Christianity and his devotion to his God. He believed what St. Francis taught us almost a thousand years ago, that we should strive to live our lives in perfect imitation of Christ. We should turn every day, and every moment, and every interaction into a prayer. Charlie understood the great paradox that is only by surrender to God, that God's power can flow into our lives and make us effective human beings. Christ died at 33 years old, but He changed the trajectory of history. Charlie died at 31 years old, but because he had surrendered, he also has now changed the trajectory of history."

Then Donald Trump, Jr. (start 6:14) and Vice President JD Vance (start 6:29) spoke, and then the one we had all been waiting for, Erika.

Mrs. Erika Kirk (start 6:51) spoke of the deep love she and Charlie had for one another, the centrality of Christ in their lives, their mutual and total submission to the will of God, her overwhelming grief at his loss, and her gratitude for all who came to remember Charlie. She spoke of their beautiful marriage, and challenged men and women to get married and build a noble and beautiful marriage according to God's design. She shared great wisdom for marriage. Her supreme devotion to Christ, strong faith in Him, and personal identification with Jesus were revealed when she said: "My husband, Charlie, he wanted to save young men, just like the one who took his life. That young man. That young man. On the cross, our Savior said, 'Father, forgive them, for they not know what they do.' That young man. That young man. I forgive him! I forgive him because it is what Christ did, and it is what Charlie would do. The answer to hate is not hate. The answer from the Gospel we know is love, and always love. President Donald Trump (start 7:22) was the final speaker.
