ACORCA Formed to be Guttmacher of Africa

In late 2024, the African Coalition for Research & Communication on Abortion (ACORCA; French: COARCA), was formed by 16 founding members to be what appears as a Guttmacher Institute for the continent of Africa. It is the first African-led organization formed for this purpose. IF they succeed in their mission and vision, the people of Africa will be deceived into believing that abortion is a "fundamental human right" for "every woman and girl" in Africa; that there is nothing wrong with murdering their posterity in the womb; and every government would authorize abortifacients and abortion on demand. I hope the God-fearing, righteous, life-giving, life-loving, family-loving Africans in every nation rise up and repel this evil invasion, protect their future generations, restore cultures of life, and restore righteous governments.

The ACORCA Mission is "To advance policy-relevant research, evidence-based advocacy and partnerships that drive transformative policies, practices and societal change for equitable access to safe abortion across Africa." They want to change the minds of Africans and their societies to embrace abortion – the deliberate killing of an unborn child – as "safe"; and influence governments to remove all abortion restrictions; and shape practices, including in medical institutions, to

accept, approve, and perform abortions as routine medical care.

The ACORCA Vision is for "An Africa where every woman and girl has access to safe, high-quality abortion services, free from stigma, enabling them to exercise their full reproductive rights with dignity and autonomy." They want "every woman and girl" to be free to abort (kill) her unborn child without spousal or parental knowledge or consent, and without anyone saying or doing anything that could cause them to feel guilt or shame for what they did to their baby.
