Doctors, Nurses & Single Mothers in Rwanda Open to Sanctity of Human Life Truth

Something unexpected and remarkable occurred in Rwanda on 23 and 24 May 2025: doctors and nurses at two hospitals were open to come to a “**Public Lecture on the Sanctity of Human Life.**” They had never received a lecture or presentation from pro-life leaders, as evidenced by the lead doctor at the first hospital who introduced us to talk about “safe abortion.” I immediately clarified that we were there to talk about the sanctity of human life, and to give them a historical and global overview of the tragedy of abortion.

First I presented selected parts of the lesson on “**Scientific and Medical Evidence of the Humanity of the Baby in the Womb,**” to ensure they had seen photos of child development in the womb, and of aborted human babies. Also, I wanted to inform them of the deliberate redefinition of “contraception” that opened the door for contraceptives that could cause early, undetected abortions. In 1965, the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology arbitrarily changed their definition of conception to: “Conception is the implantation of a fertilized ovum.” After they did this, Dr. J. C. Willke, MD, observed, this “redefinition of the terms used (was) misinformation. . . . This has fooled untold numbers of people, including many doctors. But we are not talking about the mother’s body. It is quite obvious that life does not begin when this new human life is one week old. Life begins when the sperm penetrates the ovum.”

Then I shared with the full PowerPoint slide presentation of a “**Historical & Global Overview of Nations Protecting Life or Authorizing Abortion.**” We shared the true story with maps, graphs

and tables covering the world from 1803 to 2024. We also gave them briefing folders that included maps tracking what has occurred in Africa, and a few copies of the “Abortion Worldwide Report” book. They were stunned! One doctor expressed their sadness and shock. Another asked what could or should they do. So I addressed matters of conscience and complicity. Whatever they do to save human life, even if they don’t succeed, is right and there is no blood guiltiness if the patient dies. But if they act to intentionally take life – as in an elective abortion – or are complicit in it, then they are guilty of innocent bloodshed. It is vital for them to follow their conscience, and if they are placed in a situation like Daniel or his friends (book of Daniel) or Peter and the apostles, to remember: “We must obey God rather than man” (Acts 5:29). They deeply appreciated and were encouraged by our time together.

On Sunday, 25 May 2025, Pastor & Mrs. John Rwakazayire – who had arranged the above meetings – took us to their ministry location for **Rwanda Breath of Life Ministries**. There we met, spoke with, encouraged, prayed for, and blessed about 40 single mothers and their babies.

In 1977, the Rwanda government authorized abortion with restrictions. In 2012, the government authorized abortifacient pills, effectively permitting abortion on demand during early pregnancy. The doctors and nurses appeared to believe that they must permit or do abortions to obey the government. I encouraged them to be people of integrity like Daniel, who was so faithful they could find no fault in him, but when he was commanded to do something that violated his faith and conscience, that was against the will of GOD, he chose to “obey GOD rather than man” and accept the consequences.

PRAY that doctors and nurses in your nation, and every nation, would be restored to their original call to save lives; and be restored and supported in practicing their faith in their profession with a clear conscience; and would walk in the reverential fear of the LORD just as Daniel and his friends, and Peter and the apostles did, even at the risk of their lives. PRAY also for the single mothers and babies we met in Rwanda, and those in your community, for them to know and follow Jesus in purity and faithfulness, and discover His plan and will for their lives.

With gratitude for the LORD, the sacred gift of life, and remembrance of the babies,
