

Scriptures Revealing the Sanctity of Human Life 2 (which most pastors & people may not know)

When you receive this email, I'll be in flight to Africa for three weeks of teaching, speaking, and ministry in Kenya and Rwanda. I'll give my first report in next week's GLC Weekly. Meanwhile, here are some more Scriptures I discovered about the sanctity of human life. I pray these are encouraging to you as you realize how highly God values life, including you!

"Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness' ... God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them" (Genesis 1:26-27).

"Then the LORD God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of **life**; and man became a **living** being" (Genesis 2:7).

"Now the man called his wife's name **Eve** ('life' or 'living'), because she was the mother of all the **living**" (Genesis 3:20).

"In the day when God created man, He made him in the likeness of God. He created them male and female, and He blessed them and named them Man in the day when they were created" (Genesis 5:1-2).

"And God blessed Noah and his sons and said to them, 'Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth'" (Genesis 9:1).

"Surely I will require your **lifeblood** ... from every man, from every man's brother I will require the **life** of man. Whoever sheds man's blood, by man his blood shall be shed, for in the image of God He made man" (Genesis 9:5-6).

"He lifted his eyes and saw the women and the children, and said, 'Who are these with you?' So he said, 'The children whom God has graciously given your servant'" (Genesis 33:5).

"Now do not be grieved or angry with yourselves, because you sold me here, for God sent me before you to preserve **life**" (Genesis 45:5).

"From the God of your father who helps you, and by the Almighty who blesses you with blessings of heaven above ... blessings of the breasts and of the womb" (Genesis 49:25).

"You shall not murder" (Exodus 20:13).

"Do not kill the innocent or the righteous, for I will not acquit the guilty" (Exodus 23:7).

"So I (the LORD) will turn toward you and make you fruitful and multiply you, and I will confirm My covenant with you" (Leviticus 26:9).

"You are He who brought me forth from the womb; You made me trust when upon my mother's breasts. Upon You I was cast from birth; You have been my God from my mother's womb" (Psalm 22:9-10).

"For You are my hope; O Lord GOD, You are my confidence from my youth. By You I have been sustained from my birth; You are He who took me from my mother's womb; my praise is continually of You" (Psalm 71:5-6).

"Know that the LORD Himself is God; it is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; we are His people and the sheep of His pasture" (Psalm 100:3).

"Behold, children are a gift of the LORD, the fruit of the womb is a reward" (Psalm 127:3).

PRAY that this true knowledge from the LORD about the sanctity of human life and evil of murder, child sacrifice and abortion would be fully restored to pastors and the Church, and realized by all the nations, motivating each one of us to protect the sacred gift of every life.
