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Biblical Truth About Abortion, Part 2: How Does GOD View Child Sacrifice?

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There are great differences of opinion about abortion, though perhaps less about child sacrifice because it is so visible that a living child is being sacrificed, being murdered. Abortion is almost invisible, being intentionally hidden, especially from the mother. More important than any of our opinions is what does GOD think? How does GOD view child sacrifice?

1. GOD is the Creator and Giver of life: Genesis 1:1, 26-27: "1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ... 26 Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness' . . . 27 God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them." Genesis 4:1: "Now the man had relations with his wife Eve, and she conceived and gave birth to Cain, and she said, 'I have gotten a manchild with [the help of] the LORD.'"
2. GOD creates each child in the womb, and brings that child to birth: Psalm 139:13-14: "13 For You formed my inward parts; You wove me in my mother's womb. 14 I will give thanks to You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; wonderful are Your works, and my soul knows it very well." Psalm 22:9-10: "9 Yet You are He who brought me forth from the womb; You made me trust [when] upon my mother's breasts. 10 Upon You I was cast from birth; You have been my God from my mother's womb."
3. GOD authorized government especially to protect human life, and prohibit murder: Genesis 9:6: "Whoever sheds man's blood, by man his blood shall be shed, for in the image of God He made man." Exodus 20:13: "You shall not murder."



4. GOD sees child sacrifice as murder, innocent bloodshed, and sacrificing children to demons: Exodus 21:22-23: "22 If men struggle with each other and strike a woman with child so that she gives birth prematurely, yet there is no injury, he shall surely be fined as the woman's husband may demand of him, and he shall pay as the judges [decide.] 23 But if there is [any further] injury, then you shall appoint [as a penalty] life for life." Psalm 106:37-38:

“37 They even sacrificed their sons and their daughters to the demons, 38 and shed innocent blood, the blood of their sons and their daughters, whom they sacrificed to the idols of Canaan; and the land was polluted with the blood.”

5. Sacrificing children is an abomination to GOD and profanes His holy name: Leviticus 18:21, 26: “21 You shall not give any of your offspring to offer them to Molech, nor shall you profane the name of your God; I am the LORD. ... 26 But as for you, you are to keep My statutes and My judgments and shall not do any of these abominations, [neither] the native, nor the alien who sojourns among you.”
6. GOD judged and destroyed pagan nations for sacrificing their children: Leviticus 18:24-25: “24 . . . by all these the nations which I [The LORD] am casting out before you have become defiled. 25 For the land has become defiled, therefore I have brought its punishment upon it, so the land has spewed out its inhabitants.” Deuteronomy 20:16-18: “16 Only in the cities of these peoples that the LORD your God is giving you as an inheritance, you shall not leave alive anything that breathes. 17 But you shall utterly destroy them, the Hittite and the Amorite, the Canaanite and the Perizzite, the Hivite and the Jebusite, as the LORD your God has commanded you, 18 so that they may not teach you to do according to all their detestable things which they have done for their gods, so that you would sin against the LORD your God” (see Genesis 15:16-21).
7. GOD commanded His people not to sacrifice their children to idols or do other abominations practiced by the pagan nations: Leviticus 18:24, 29-30: “24 Do not defile yourselves by any of these things . . . 29 For whoever does any of these abominations, those persons who do [so] shall be cut off from among their people. 30 Thus you are to keep My charge, that you do not practice any of the abominable customs which have been practiced before you, so as not to defile yourselves with them; I am the LORD your God.”
8. If GOD’s people, or those living in their land, sacrifice their children, they defile His sanctuary and profane His name: Leviticus 20:1-5: “1 Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, 2 ‘You shall also say to the sons of Israel: “Any man from the sons of Israel or from the aliens sojourning in Israel who gives any of his offspring to Molech, shall surely be put to death; the people of the land shall stone him with stones. 3 I will also set My face against that man and will cut him off from among his people, because he has given some of his offspring to Molech, so as to defile My sanctuary and to profane My holy name. 4 If the people of the land, however, should ever disregard that man when he gives any of his offspring to Molech, so as not to put him to death, 5 then I Myself will set My face against that man and against his family, and I will cut off from among their people both him and all those who play the harlot after him, by playing the harlot after Molech.””
9. GOD never imagined that His own people would sacrifice their children: Jeremiah 19:4-5: “4 Because they have forsaken Me and have made this an alien place and have burned sacrifices in it to other gods, that neither they nor their forefathers nor the kings of Judah had [ever] known, and [because] they have filled this place with the blood of the innocent 5

and have built the high places of Baal to burn their sons in the fire as burnt offerings to Baal, a thing which I never commanded or spoke of, nor did it [ever] enter My mind.”

10. GOD judged and removed His own people for their idolatry and sacrificing their children: Jeremiah 19:6-7 [continuing from above] “‘6 therefore, behold, days are coming,’ declares the LORD, ‘when this place will no longer be called Topheth or the valley of Ben-hinnom, but rather the valley of Slaughter. 7 I will make void the counsel of Judah and Jerusalem in this place, and I will cause them to fall by the sword before their enemies and by the hand of those who seek their life; and I will give over their carcasses as food for the birds of the sky and the beasts of the earth.’”
11. GOD said He would not forgive the shedding of innocent blood of children: 2 Kings 24:2-4: “2 The LORD sent against him [King Manasseh] bands of Chaldeans, bands of Arameans, bands of Moabites, and bands of Ammonites. So He sent them against Judah to destroy it, according to the word of the LORD which He had spoken through His servants the prophets. 3 Surely at the command of the LORD it came upon Judah, to remove [them] from His sight because of the sins of Manasseh, according to all that he had done, 4 and also for the innocent blood which he shed, for he filled Jerusalem with innocent blood; and the LORD would not forgive” (see 2 Kings 16).
12. GOD did forgive individuals who repented: 2 Chronicles 33:2, 6, 9-13: “2 He [King Manasseh] did evil in the sight of the LORD according to the abominations of the nations whom the LORD dispossessed before the sons of Israel. ... 6 He made his sons pass through the fire in the valley of Ben-hinnom; and he practiced witchcraft . . . He did much evil in the sight of the LORD, provoking Him [to anger.] ... 9 Thus Manasseh misled Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to do more evil than the nations whom the LORD destroyed before the sons of Israel. 10 The LORD spoke to Manasseh and his people, but they paid no attention. 11 Therefore the LORD brought the commanders of the army of the king of Assyria against them, and they captured Manasseh with hooks, bound him with bronze [chains] and took him to Babylon. 12 When he was in distress, he entreated the LORD his God and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers. 13 When he prayed to Him, He was moved by his entreaty and heard his supplication, and brought him again to Jerusalem to his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD [was] God.”

Now you know.

PRAY that the Holy Spirit will open the eyes and hearts of Americans – clergy, the Church, government leaders, teachers, students, media, etc. – to understand how GOD sees child sacrifice (and abortion), and to see our nation, what we have done and what we are doing, as He sees us; and bring us back to Him in genuine humility and repentance.
